

Proposed Restoration planting Areas

No.	Management Unit	District	Forest Reserves	Details
1	Budongo System Range	Kibaale	Kangombe	The CFR is proposed for restoration planting with provision for offset planting along the boundary. A buffer of 300m-1km along the boundary may be planted with fast growing trees while the inner part is left for restoration. The proposal should have a component for restoration planting of trees for government/NFA (to be handed over after 3-5 years) as management may further guide.
2	Lakeshore Range	Mukono and Buyikwe	All CFRs	Consideration should be made by potential tree farmers, to have a percentage area next to a wetland, left as a restoration area (between 60-30% of the allocated area), to be planted with species such as Measopsis eminii, Terminalia superba etc. A proposal to have at least 20-10% of the restoration trees planted will be left (should not be harvested) for NFA, at the end of the license/one rotation. A reasonable area along the external boundary, could be planted with eucalyptus sp, or other fast-growing tree species, to protect the CFR boundary.
