KASYOHA-KITOMI CENTRAL FOREST RESERVE.

It is located Rubirizi District 35 km from Bushenyi town under the management of Kasyo-kitomi sector; Southwest Range. It covers an area of 433 sq.km. It is approximately 5-6 hours drive from Kampala to Rubirizi district (363.1 km) via Masaka Rd and Mbarara - Kasese Road

 - Waterfalls (at least 5metres high) along river Rubale next to Kanyara village
